13 Days Pilgrimage to the Marian Shrines Start From US 08/07/2024 - 08/19/2024

DAY 6 – 12 AUG - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA CATHEDRAL, CRYPT OF ST. JAMES CITY TOUR

This morning we begin our visit to Santiago de Compostela, one of the most famous shrines in the world, where the tomb of St. James (brother of St. John the Divine) was discovered. St. Jvbames was given the task of spreading Christianity in the distant Hispanic lands and is known as the first pilgrim. Since the discovery of the tomb, numerous miracles have taken place here and every year thousands of faithful gather on July 25 to celebrate the Feast Day. We begin with a visit to the Cathedral of St. James, one of the finest examples of architecture in all of Europe. As pilgrims, we have the opportunity to climb the stairs behind the high altar to visit the crypt where the relics of St. James are preserved, touch the central pillar (Portico de La Gloria), view the 'botafumeiro' and admire the wealth of medieval art inside the Cathedral, before visiting the cloister museum. Enjoy a stroll on your own, through the beautiful streets of Santiago de Compostela, the city of the apostle, full of historical buildings and others. Dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela. – 2 LOCAL GUIDES

*If Fr Maristela prefers, the group can attend the Pilgrims Mass at 12:00 and he can concelebrate. Please inform, so I can advise the cathedral

DAY 7 – 13 AUG - OVIEDO /SANTANDER: CATHEDRAL OF OVIEDO, TOMS OF ASTURIAN KINGS, CAMARA SANTA

Depart Santiago this morning and drive to Oviedo, the capital of Asturias region. Here we will visit the Cathedral which houses the tombs of Asturian kings and the Camara Santa, a restored 9th century chapel containing expressive statues of Christ and the Apostles. We then head to Santander for dinner and overnight. 2 LOCAL GUIDES

DAY 8 - 14 AUG - SANTANDER / LOYOLA / LOURDES

This morning we depart hotel and drive to Loyola, the hometown of Saint Ignatius of Loyola, the

founder of the Jesuits. Here you will visit the Basilica and the tower house where he was born and lived. We continued to Lourdes for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 – 15 AUG - LOURDES: GROTTO OF MASSABIELLE, BASILICA OF ST PIUS X, BATHS, CANDLELIGHT PROCESSION:

This day we start with a mass at the Grotto of Massabielle, where our Lady appeared to Bernadette in 1858. Later we took our official group photo in front of the Basilica, followed by our guided tour of Lourdes. The sanctuary of the Basilica of St. Pius X, the world's largest underground church. The Basilica, The Baths, where thousands of miraculous cures have taken place is the most respected shrine and sanctuary in France. In the afternoon our group will join the Blessed Sacrament Procession and Blessing of the Sick, (if available on that day). 2 LOCAL GUIDES

DAY 10 – 16 AUG - PARIS / LOURDES: CANDLELIGHT PROCESSION: After breakfast we check out. After breakfast, we will celebrate Mass. Then transfer to the train station, from where we depart on the TGV trains to Paris at 12:29 pm (approx 4,5 hrs trip). Once we arrive, transfer to the hotel for check in. Restaurant dinner and overnight

DAY 11 – 17 AUG - PARIS / VERSAILLES / CHARTRES: PALACE OF VERSAILLES, NOTRE DAME DE CHARTRES: This morning we drive to Chartres to visit the Notre-Dame de Chartres (the Cathedral of Our Lady of Chartres). This Cathedral is considered one of the finest examples in all of France of the Gothic style of architecture. After lunch, we drive to Versailles, best known as the site of the magnificent Palace of Versailles, built by King Louis XIV during the 1600s and was the royal residence for more than 100 years. Return to Paris in evening. Restaurant dinner. 3 LOCAL GUIDES IN VERSAILLES

*Please note that in order to give time to enjoy the visit and some time at leisure both in Chartres and in Versailles, I have not booked a mass on this day



DAY 12- 18 AUG - PARIS: NOTRE DAME, HOLY CHAPEL, CHAMPS ELYSEES, EIFFEL TOWER: After breakfast, we will enjoy a tour to see a stunning example of Gothic architecture that took two centuries and armies of medieval workers to complete - The Notre Dame Cathedral (outside) and then we visit Sainte-Chapelle "Holy Chapel", and its stained glass, which is considered the best of its type in the world. After lunch, we will drive to Rue de Bac church for Mass, where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Saint Catherine Labouré and requested the creation of the medal which came to be known as the Miraculous Medal. Then we head to St Vincent de Paul church, built in the 19th century on the site of the ancient Saint-Lazare enclosure. The enclosure was occupied by Saint Vincent de Paul and the Congregation de la Mission from 1632 to 1793 - it was here that he had lived and worked. Later we will enjoy a panoramic tour to see the Arc de Triomphe, the Champs Elysees, and the Tour Eiffel. Then we will enjoy a river cruise and a restaurant dinner near the Eiffel Tower. Return to the hotel. 2 LOCAL GUIDES
