



- **Credit Card(s)** – Advise creditor of international travel dates & locations.
- **Credit Card(s)** – Check and confirm regarding International Transaction Fee(s) with your bank. ( **Visa or Mastercard** )
- **Bank Card** – Advise your bank of international travel dates and locations.
- **.Cell Phone** – Check with the carrier for international calls/data plans if you'd like, however; there is Wi-Fi almost everywhere, including in the buses and it is free of charge.
- **Photocopy Credit Card(s), Bank Card(s), & Passport** – This is a precautionary measure.
- **Leave Travel Details with Local Contact** – Provide them with the itinerary and/or our contact information.
- **Cash for Arrival, a couple of 100 euros should be enough** – The tour guide will aid you in exchanging the currency should you desire. The exchange rate is the same in most places, except at the banks and the hotels. So please feel confident in allowing the tour guide to assist you. You **need some Euros for lunch** or you can use your credit card
- ( Mastercard or Visa Card ) We suggest you bring small bills such as **euro 5.00 and euro 10.00** for gratuities and other items you may desire to purchase.
- **Adapters for European Outlets** – We will provide adapters. If you need one, please let us know. They are free of charge. We only ask that you please bring it back to us after you finish. Please do not worry if they get lost.
- **Liquid on flight-** Make sure no more than 3 oz of liquid on your carry on
- **Prescriptions** – Up to date and sufficient supply for travel dates. We suggest extra medications as a precautionary measure.
- **Shoes for travel and walking** – to stay comfortable throughout the pilgrimage. **Proper clothing** considering weather conditions.
