



# Our Terms

**Terms and Conditions:** Any payments made by an individual, group, or entity to Holy Land Tours and Travels, LLC for a pilgrimage package by default constitutes unconditional agreement with the terms and conditions stated here. **REGISTRATION:** To reserve space on a pilgrimage, a deposit of \$250 (payable by cash, check, or money order) is required along with a completed, signed, and dated registration form or by completing the registration form online. Registrations are processed in the order they are received by Holy Land Tours and Travels, LLC and registration is completed only when both the deposit and the completed registration form are received. A registration form with incomplete information is not considered complete until all required information is submitted.

**PILGRIMAGE PREPARATION MATERIALS:** No later than one month before departure, participants and groups will receive (via email) online preparation materials from Holy Land Tours and Travels, LLC. Within one week of return, individuals and groups will also receive (via email) follow-up materials to aid in unpacking the pilgrimage experience. Groups can also elect to receive materials for in-person discussion groups, to be led by a leader, chaplain, or volunteer of the group.

**BAGGAGE:** International destinations typically are allowed one free piece of luggage, but Travels is not responsible for any luggage fees or any other expenses incurred by individuals traveling on a group flight. Participants are also required to porter their own luggage between all destinations. We strongly recommend that you pack only one piece of checked luggage and one carry-on. Holy Land Tours and Travels is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of any bags or items at any time.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** All group airline tickets are round-trip, economy class tickets and are non-refundable from the time of ticketing. Participants on a group flight cannot use frequent file miles to purchase their tickets, although they can add their frequent flyer number to their paid ticket when they arrive at the airport. Any cancellations, alterations, or failure to use confirmed space will be subject to the penalties and fees given by the airline. Please note that airfares, airline carriers, and schedules are always subject to change without notice. While Holy Land Tours and Travels, LLC attempts at accurately anticipating required airline taxes, fees, and fuel surcharges, any excess fees levied by the airlines beyond the original total price at time of booking will be the responsibility of the individual participant. 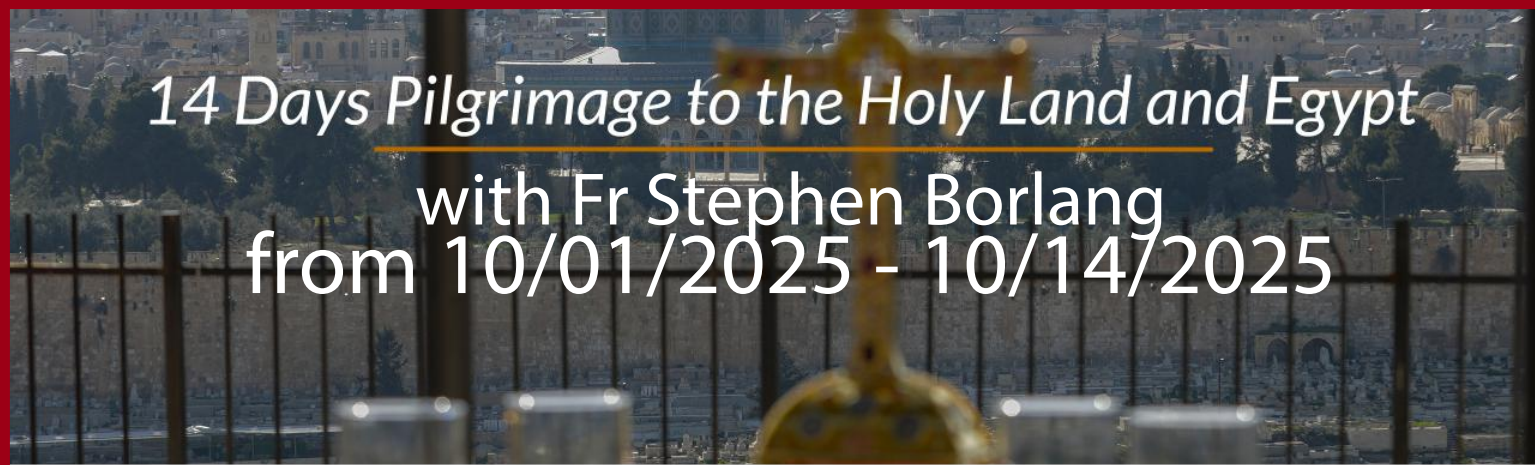
**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** All participants on a Holy Land Tours and Travels pilgrimage must have appropriate travel documents. On pilgrimages that leave the country, all participants are required to have a valid passport. Passports must be valid at least six months past the date of anticipated return. It is the individual's responsibility to secure any necessary visas or other travel paperwork. Non-U.S. citizens should check with their appropriate governmental agencies to ensure their understanding of travel requirements. It is the responsibility of the individual to obtain all necessary travel documents (i.e. passports or visas) needed to participate.

### Day 1

Depart from local USA international airport to Tel Aviv international airport (Ben Gurion).



### Day 2

Arrive in the Holy Land. Meet our tour guide who will escort us throughout our pilgrimage. Drive to Nazareth or Tiberias. Dinner and overnight in Nazareth or Tiberias.



### Day 3

After breakfast, start our day with a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. Then visit Capernaum and the House of Peter, Magdala, the "Jesus Boat" at Nof Ginosaur, the Church of Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes at Tabgha, and St. Peter's Church on the sea. Dinner and overnight in Nazareth or Tiberias.



### Day 4

After breakfast, drive to Cana of Galilee, the place commemorating the first miracle of Jesus. After that, drive to view Mt. Carmel, and then continue to Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, St. Joseph Church, and the old Synagogue. Dinner and overnight in Nazareth or Tiberias.



### Day 5

After breakfast, drive to Mt. Tabor to visit the Church of the Transfiguration. Then, drive along the Jordan Valley to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.



### Day 6

After breakfast, tour the Old City of Jerusalem. Start with St. Anne Church and the Pool of Bethesda, and the Chapel of Flagellation. Continue along the Via Dolorosa to visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Walk to the Wailing Wall. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.



### Day 7

After breakfast, drive to the Mount of Olives to enjoy a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Visit the Chapel of Ascension and the Pater Noster Church. Continue walking to Dominus Flevit, the Garden and the Church of Gethsemane, Mt. Zion, Dormition Abbey, David's Tomb, the Cenacle or Upper Room, and the church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.



### Day 8

After breakfast, tour Bethlehem. Visit the Nativity Church, Milk Grotto, the Shepherd's Fields, and the Old City of Bethlehem. Enjoy a cultural dinner with the Christian family in Shepherd's Field. Overnight in Bethlehem.

## Day 9

After breakfast, drive on to Jericho to see the Mount of Temptation and the Sycamore tree of Zacchaeus. Visit the Jordan River and the baptismal site, Later visit the Dead Sea and caves at Qumran. Overnight in Bethlehem.



## Day 10

After breakfast, we start our day driving to Eilat, southeast of Israel, in a premium air-conditioned coach to cross the border of Egypt. Meet our representatives for a private transfer to your hotel. If possible we will visit some places in Sinai. Overnight in Sinai.



## Day 11

At early day break, those who are who are physically capable will climb-up Mount Sinai Jabal Musa, (6,900 ft) to the summit walking in the Footsteps of Moses and enjoy a time of praise and amazing views of the Sinai wilderness. Imagine yourself here reading the Book of Genesis where God revealed himself to Moses in the Burning Bush and where he received the Ten Commandments. After our descent from the mountain we return to the hotel to rejoin the rest of the group for breakfast. After breakfast, we drive to St. Catherine Monastery and spend the day touring and visiting landmarks in Sinai. Overnight in Sinai.

- If you cancel between 60-35 days of the travel date, you can receive a refund of 25% of your payments.
