

Please find below some important travel-related reminders for your upcoming trip

- 1. Credit Card(s) Notify your credit card issuer(s) of your international travel dates and locations.
- 2. International Transaction Fees Confirm with your bank regarding any international transaction fees for your credit card (Visa or Mastercard).
- 3. Bank Cash Card Inform your bank of your international travel dates and locations.
- 4. Cell Phone Check with your carrier for international call/data plans. However, please note that Wi-Fi is available in most locations, including on the buses, and is free of charge.
- 5. Photocopy of Credit Cards, Bank Cards, and Passport For your security, we recommend making photocopies of these important documents.
- 6. Leave Travel Details with a Local Contact Share your itinerary and/or our contact information with someone back home.
- 7. Cash for Arrival We recommend having a small amount of cash (approximately 300 Euros) upon arrival. The tour guide will assist you with exchanging currency if needed. Most places have the same exchange rate, but it may vary at banks or hotels. You may also use your credit card (Mastercard or Visa) for purchases or meals. For gratuities and small purchases, we suggest bringing small bills, such as 5- and 10-Euro notes.
- 8. Adapters for European Outlets We will provide adapters for your use. If you need one, please let us know; they are free of charge. We kindly ask that you return the adapter after use. Don't worry if one is lost during the trip.
- 9. Prescriptions Ensure you have an up-to-date and sufficient supply of any necessary medications for the duration of your travels. We suggest bringing extra medication as a precaution.
- 10. Shoes for Travel and Walking Comfortable shoes are essential to ensure your comfort throughout the pilgrimage.
- 11. Appropriate Clothing Please pack clothing suitable for the weather conditions.
