This morning we visit St. Peter's Basilica; the largest Catholic Basilica ever built, and celebrate mass there. Its soaring dome was engineered by Michelangelo and the artist's famous Pieta sculpture and countless other artistic wonders making St. Peter's church one of the most awe-inspiring buildings in the world. 13 JUN - Day 5: St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major & Walking Tour:

In the morning, we visit the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the oldest basilica in the Western World. We then visit the Holy Stairs, believed to be those that led to the praetorian of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem, and the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the oldest and most important shrines in the world dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. We will also be celebrating mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major. In the afternoon we go on a walking tour passing by the famous Colosseum – the largest ancient amphitheater in the world and the site of countless gladiator games. Continue to the Roman Forum, the administrative capital of the Empire and the site of some of the most famous speeches in history by the likes of Julius Caesar, Mark Anthony, and Cicero. We continue walking to marvel at the sight of the illuminated Trevi Fountain before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight. Overnight: Rome (Breakfast, Dinner)

(2 hrs. drive) This medieval city is the birthplace of St. Catherine "Doctor of the Church", and the Apostle of Italy, St. Bernardine. Visit the Basilica of St. Catherine (which is also known as the Basilica of St. Domenico). St. Catherine passed a large part of her life inside the walls of this Basilica which today houses relics of the Saint. After, visit the Shrine of St. Catherine, which occupies the site of her family home. Afterward, we visit the Basilica de San Francesco for the Eucharistic Miracle of hosts. Enjoy your walking tour through the Siena including a visit to its Cathedral (Duomo di Siena). Conclude at one of Italy's finest squares, the Piazza Del Campo, where we will be given free time to spend at leisure. There are several restaurants surrounding the square to have lunch, as well as shops for gifts and souvenirs. We then transfer to our home in Pisa for the night. Overnight: Pisa (Breakfast, Dinner)

17 JUN - Day 9: Pisa/ Florence/Pisa:

Today we have a full-day tour of the Renaissance city of Florence. Free time during lunch to explore the famous San Lorenzo market. In the afternoon, we will explore the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, with its great representation of Tuscan Gothic Architecture, like the giant dome of the church, designed by Brunelleschi. We will see Giotto’s Bell Tower, a 14th-century masterpiece that rises to a height of 292 feet, and the Baptistry of San Giovanni, with East Door which is called the Gates of Paradise. The doors took artist Ghiberti 27 years to complete. Then we will visit Michelangelo’s parish church, Santa Croce, where Dante is buried. We then visit the Piazza della Signoria and potentially take a bus to Piazza Michelangelo if possible. We celebrate mass potentially at the Duomo before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight. Overnight: Pisa (Breakfast, Dinner)

18 JUN - Day 10: Pisa/ Padua/Venice:

Today we depart for Padua, stopping first in Pisa. Pisa is a city in Italy's Tuscany region best known for its iconic Leaning Tower. Already tilting when it was completed in 1372, the 56m white marble cylinder is the bell tower of the Romanesque, striped marble Cathedral that rises next to it in the Piazza dei Miracoli. Also in the piazza is the Baptistery, whose renowned acoustics are demonstrated by amateur singers daily, and the Caposanto Monastery. We then continue to Padua to visit the Basilica of St Anthony. We will see his uncorrupt tongue over 760 years ago, more than 30 years after his death. This scientifically inexplicable phenomenon is what faith calls a miracle, seeing that the relic of the tongue, the instrument used by St Anthony for preaching, is still visible and uncorrupt after many centuries. The relic may be venerated in the Chapel of the Treasury in the Basilica, which is visited each year by millions of pilgrims.- We celebrate Mass and continue to the hotel for dinner and overnight.
