

Terms and Conditions: Submitting any payment to Holy Land Tours and Travel, LLC for a pilgrimage package constitutes full and unconditional acceptance of the terms and conditions outlined below.

REGISTRATION: To reserve your place on a pilgrimage, a \$250 non-refundable deposit (payable by cash, check, or money order) must accompany a completed registration form, submitted either by hard copy or online. Registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis and are confirmed only when both the deposit and all required information are received. Incomplete forms will not be processed until completed. Registration forms will be held for a maximum of three (3) days. If the deposit is not received within that time, the application will not be processed and the spot may be released to another participant.

PILGRIMAGE PREPARATION MATERIALS: At least one month before departure, participants will receive digital pilgrimage preparation materials via email. One week after returning, follow-up reflection materials will be provided. Groups may also request additional in-person resources led by a group leader, chaplain, or volunteer.

PAYMENTS: A \$250 non-refundable deposit is required at the time of registration.

Electronic payments are subject to a 3% convenience fee. Full payment must be received 90 days prior to departure. Failure to meet the deadline may result in reservation cancellation and applicable cancellation fees. Returned checks will incur a \$50 non-refundable fee. Important: Your \$250 deposit must be received within three (3) days of submitting your registration form. Applications without timely payment will not be processed.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance. Plans are available on our website: www.holylandtoursandtravel.com. Please review your chosen policy carefully.

CANCELLATION FEES AND REFUNDS: All cancellations must be submitted in writing by email or letter. Refunds (if applicable) will follow the cancellation fee schedule provided with your invoice. If Holy Land Tours and Travel, LLC cancels a pilgrimage for reasons unrelated to safety, natural disasters, acts of God, terrorism, or other force majeure events, a full refund will be issued minus non-refundable third-party deposits. For cancellations due to the above-listed events, any payments made will be credited toward future services with Holy Land Tours and Travel, LLC. No additional refunds or compensation will be issued.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Group airfare includes round-trip economy class tickets, which are non-refundable once ticketed. Frequent flyer miles cannot be used for group purchases but can be added at check-in. Airlines may impose penalties for changes or unused tickets. Holy Land Tours and Travel, LLC is not responsible for airline schedule changes, additional fees, or missed flights due to personal circumstances. Deviations from the group itinerary are not permitted. Seating requests should be made directly with the airline and are not guaranteed.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND TRANSPORTATION: Packages include accommodations in double-occupancy rooms with private bathrooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at an additional cost. Lodging will be provided in Deluxe Hotels, religious guesthouses, or similar accommodations. Ground transportation will be via private,

chartered coach, accompanied by a local guide. If a participant does not have a roommate and no match can be made by the time of final arrangements, the participant must pay the single room supplement. If unwilling to pay, Holy Land Tours and Travel, LLC reserves the right to cancel the participant's reservation and refund any payments made.

MEALS AND PERSONAL EXPENSES: Two meals per day are included during the stay in the destination country. Meals on travel days and one daily meal are not included. No refunds will be provided for missed meals. Special dietary needs can be requested but cannot be guaranteed in all locations.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have proper travel documentation. A valid passport with at least six months' validity beyond the return date is required for international pilgrimages. Travelers are responsible for obtaining any necessary visas or other documents. Non-U.S. citizens should check entry requirements based on their nationality.

HEALTH CONCERNS: We strive to accommodate participants with health concerns. However, participants must be able to walk, eat, and move independently, or bring a personal assistant at their own cost. Most destinations do not operate under ADA standards. Holy Land Tours and Travel, LLC does not guarantee access to all activities for those with limited mobility and does not offer refunds for missed activities due to physical limitations.

Due to the physically demanding nature of our pilgrimages — including extensive walking, standing, uneven terrain, and long travel days — participants requiring a wheelchair or mobility aid are not eligible to join group tours. A private pilgrimage experience tailored to your needs is recommended. Please contact us for personalized assistance.

BAGGAGE: Airlines typically allow one free checked bag on international flights; however, travelers must confirm directly with their carrier. Participants are responsible for handling their own luggage. We recommend bringing one checked bag and one carry-on. Holy Land Tours and Travel, LLC is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to baggage or personal belongings.

EXCLUSIONS: The pilgrimage fee does not include passport or visa fees, meals not specified in the itinerary, beverages, personal expenses, travel insurance, baggage fees, or incidental costs.

Day 1

Depart from San Diego international airport to board our flights to Scotland with meals and beverages served aloft.



Day 5

This morning, visit Carfin Lourdes Grotto, a beloved Scottish shrine dedicated to Our Lady of Lourdes and a place of pilgrimage and prayer for nearly a century. Return to Glasgow for a short panoramic city tour and a visit to Glasgow Cathedral (St. Mungo's), a masterpiece of Scottish Gothic architecture. Enjoy dinner and fellowship this evening.



Day 2

Arrive at Edinburgh Airport and meet your English-speaking guide. Transfer to your hotel in Edinburgh or nearby area and check in (may not be possible before 15:00). Celebrate Mass at a historic local church before gathering with your group for a welcome dinner.



Day 6

Transfer to Glasgow Airport and fly to Dublin.
Upon arrival, meet your guide and begin a
panoramic tour of Dublin City, discovering its
charming Georgian architecture, O'Connell
Street, Phoenix Park, and Merrion Square. Visit
Trinity College to view the world-famous Book
of Kells. Celebrate Mass after the tour, then
check in to your hotel. Enjoy dinner and
relaxation this evening.




Day 3

Begin your day with Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral. Visit the iconic Edinburgh Castle, perched high above the city, and enjoy panoramic views of the capital. Continue with a walking tour through the Old and New Towns, both part of Edinburgh's UNESCO World Heritage Site. Later, visit the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the King's official residence in Scotland. Return to your hotel for dinner and rest.



Day 7

Drive south to the scenic Wicklow Mountains, visiting Glendalough, one of Ireland's most important monastic sites founded by St. Kevin in the 6th century. Enjoy the serene beauty of the valley and reflect on Ireland's deep Christian heritage. Continue to Tipperary and visit Baltinglass Abbey; it offers a glimpse into medieval Ireland's religious and cultural landscape. Finish the day by continuing to Castledermot Abbey. Here you can find two high crosses adomed with intricate biblical carvings, a round tower, and ogham stones—making it a place where Ireland's early Christian and medieval stories meet. Return to Dublin for dinner and overnight.



Day 4

After breakfast, travel to Glasgow, stopping in Perth, a picturesque riverside town, and St. Andrews, the ecclesiastical capital of Scotland and home to the oldest university in the country. Visit St. Andrew's Cathedral ruins and the quaint seaside town before continuing to Glasgow. Finish the day with a visit to Scone Palace, view the gothic-style antiques, and a replica of the Stone of Scone. Dinner and overnight in Glasgow.



Day 8

Visit the majestic Rock of Cashel, one of Ireland's most iconic landmarks and ancient royal seats where St. Patrick once preached. Enjoy time to explore the historic site before continuing to the scenic landscapes of County Kerry. Check in to your hotel (may not be possible before 15:00) and enjoy dinner with your group.



Discover the Dingle Peninsula, one of Ireland's most beautiful regions, rich in Christian history and Celtic heritage. Visit Gallarus Oratory, a remarkable early Christian stone church, and enjoy stunning coastal scenery. We then take a visit to Kilmakedar Church, a spectacular early-Christian site in County Kerry. Celébrate Mass and return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.



After breakfast, journey to Knock, Ireland's National Marian Shrine. Visit the Basilica, museum, and prayer grounds at this cherished site where the Blessed Virgin appeared in 1879. Participate in Mass and reflection time. Check in to your hotel and enjoy dinner and overnight.



After breakfast, take the ferry across the Shannon Estuary to County Clare. Visit the world-famous Cliffs of Moher, soaring 700 feet above the Atlantic Ocean, offering one of the most stunning views in Ireland. Continue to Galway for a panoramic city tour, discovering its vibrant streets, harbor, and lively local culture. Check in to your hotel (may not be possible before 15:00).



This morning, return to Dublin for your final day of pilgrimage. Visit the National Museum of Archaeology, home to Ireland's most treasured artifacts. Enjoy leisure time for shopping or personal reflection before a farewell dinner and traditional Irish entertainment at the Merry Ploughboys Pub.



Today we bid Scotland and Ireland farewell and board our flights home, carrying with us memories that will last a lifetime.



Enjoy a serene morning cruise along the River Corrib, passing historic castles and scenic countryside. Later, visit Clonmacnoise, a sacred monastic site founded by St. Ciarán in the 6th century, featuring ancient churches, towers, and Celtic crosses. Return to Galway for dinner and a peaceful evening.

Holy Land Tours and Travels, LLC bears no further responsibility beyond the refund. In the event that you need to cancel your trip, we understand that it can be frustrating to lose out on your investment. That's why we advise you to purchase travel insurance that covers cancellation for covered reasons, medical expenses, and lost baggage. Single Room Information: In cases where a participant registers without a designated roommate, we will do our best to match them with another traveler. Please note: To secure your spot, the \$250 deposit must be received within three (3) days of submitting the registration form. Applications without timely payment will not be processed. A \$250 deposit is non-refundable.

Once airline tickets (including upgrades) are issued, they are 100% non-refundable regardless of the cancellation date. If you cancel 90 days or more before the trip, you are eligible for a refund of 75% of the total trip price, minus the deposit. If you cancel between 89 and 60 days before the trip, you are eligible for a refund of 50% of the total trip price, minus the deposit. If you cancel between 59 and 35 days before the trip, you are eligible for a refund of 25% of the total trip price, minus the deposit. Cancellation Fees:
