

The Seven Churches of Revelation & Greek Islands

A 13-Day Pilgrimage to Istanbul, Turkey, and Greece
with Fr. Stephen Borlang
from October 6th, 2026 - October 18th, 2026



Day 1

Depart from your local international airport. Enjoy onboard meals and prepare for your pilgrimage ahead. Overnight flight to Istanbul.



Day 2

Welcome to Istanbul, Turkey! Your private assistant, welcoming you at the arrival hall of the International Terminal of Istanbul Airport, holding a sign bearing your name, will escort you to your hotel for check-in and relaxation. Dinner and overnight in the Istanbul hotel.



Day 3

After breakfast, you begin your exploration of fascinating Istanbul with the priceless pieces of history available at your doorstep. You begin at the remains of the Hippodrome. The next stop will be the Basilica of Saint Sophia, one of the largest Christian shrines ever built in history. Then, you see the serene Blue Mosque, one of Istanbul's most venerable monuments. Continue with the magnificent Topkapı Palace, the residence of the sultans for almost three centuries. We will visit the Hagia Irene. Then you will visit the Grand Bazaar (Kapalı Carsi) – Grand Bazaar is one of the earliest shopping malls ever built in history, which maintains its charm and volume of business to the modern day with its indoor and outdoor sections. Dinner and overnight in the Istanbul hotel.



Day 4

After breakfast we drove to Iznik for a visit. Late afternoon we continued our drive to Bursa. Dinner and overnight at a Hotel in Bursa.



Day 5

After breakfast, we will drive to Pergamum to visit the Asklepion and the Acropolis. Pergamon was a very important attraction center for those who wanted to study, to practice, to heal, and to present offerings to the gods and goddesses. Today's tour is a trip to western Anatolia. After we finish the visits around Pergamum, we drive to Izmir. Dinner and overnight will be at the Hotel in Izmir.



Day 6

After breakfast at the hotel. We will drive to Thyateira. Then continue to Sardis. Our last stop will be Philadelphia. Dinner and overnight in Pamukkale Hotel.



Day 7

Today, you will visit Hierapolis and Laodicea. Once you reach the lower slopes of the hills that rise behind the site, you will note one of the best preserved Roman Theatres of the world of archaeology. Continue to Laodicea, where the ruins of one of the seven biblical churches of Asia remain. After Laodicea, we will drive to Kusadasi. Dinner and overnight in the Kusadasi Hotel.



Day 8

After breakfast at the hotel. We will drive to Ephesus. You will start your Ephesus excursion at the upper Magnesia Gate, and work your way down through the city, ending near the ancient Harbor. Along the way, you will see the Forum, the Odeon, the Library of Celsius, the Thermal Baths of Scholastic, and the Great Theater, built in the Greek era and reconstructed in the Roman period. You will walk along the Arcadian Way, where once Mark Antony and Cleopatra rode in procession. After the Phehus visit, we will drive back to the Kusadasi hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in the Kusadasi Hotel.



Day 9

This afternoon we spent our time cruising the beautiful, blue Aegean, arriving after lunch in Patmos. Patmos is the beautiful island where the exiled St. John the Divine received the Revelation, which forms the last book of the New Testament. An excursion to the Holy Cave of the Apocalypse, the Grotto of the Revelation, and then on to the 11th-century Monastery of St. John, which houses an original manuscript of the Gospel. Enjoy the panoramic view from this superb, fortress-like complex, high on a hill. Included Shore Excursion.



Day 10

Early morning arrival in Rhodes. This fortified stronghold was built by a Crusading Order that originated from Palestine. After your stroll, enjoy the cosmopolitan atmosphere from one of the elegant cafes on the yacht harbor, or take an optional excursion to visit the Temple of Athena on the majestic, rocky Acropolis of Lindos, with the blue Aegean beneath it and the sophisticated, whitewashed artists' colony at its foot. Overnight onboard.



Day 11

This morning, we woke up in Heraklion, Crete, the home of the great Minoan Civilization. Optional: Visit the Knossos excavations dating back to 4000 B.C. and the Palace. Return to our cruise ship to sail to Santorini for a visit on this interesting island. Optional: Enjoy a short trip by local boat to Athenios harbor, where we board our motor coach to visit Oia Village, built on the Caldera rim, which is an excellent example of Cycladic architecture. Proceed through the beautiful countryside to Fira, Enjoy the town at leisure or perhaps relax over a coffee as you gaze down upon Kamenes. Afterwards, return to the small pier of Scala by cable car or mule, where the vessel's tenders will take you back to the ship. Overnight on board our cruise ship.



Day 12

Today's tour will touch on the highlights of Corinth, driving through Daphni and Eleusis. After crossing the Corinthian Canal, which connects the Aegean and Ionian Seas, we will arrive in ancient Corinth. We visit the ruins of Corinth, where Paul worked with Aquila and Priscilla. Included are the First Century shops, the Agora, Temple of Apollo, and the Bema Seat. Still gurgling under the ruins is the water of the springs of the mighty Acropolis above, which once fed the Fountain of Pirene. Dinner & overnight in Athens.



Day 13

Early this morning, we transfer to the airport and departed on our flight back home with pleasant memories of the lands just visited.

Mass/Service will be celebrated daily if possible
